The Tenfold Initiative Scholarship is available to a high school senior (graduating before July 1, 2016) who is located in the Central Ohio region. Students must be enrolled or accepted at a university, college or art school as a declared major in a visual arts program for the 2016 school year. The scholarship submission consists of a completed application form (attached), four artwork samples (personal selection), a 500 word essay, and two letters of recommendation. Note: The full application form consists of four pages.

LAINEGABRIEL ART SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

[1.0] SAMPLES: The samples should include four (4) images of your artwork. Artwork can be supplied digitally (at 150 dpi or higher on a CD or DVD) or furnished on 11x17 printouts (bound books and mounting are optional). DO NOT submit originals, as they will not be accepted. For digital artwork, please name the file with your name and number 1-4 accordingly. (Example: lisamiller1.jpg.) For both printed (on the back of print) and digital artwork (on a separate piece of paper) please include: The artist's name, high school's name, title of artwork, media, dimensions, and year completed. Artwork may include drawings, paintings, printmaking, graphic design, interior design, or 3D art.

[1.1] By submitting these samples of work, you are granting LaineGabriel the right to use and publish these submissions for the support of The Tenfold Initiative scholarship program. All samples must be your work and not involve any help from additional parties. Your artwork will not be copied or sold by LaineGabriel during or following the scholarship process. Your signature at the completion of the application process signifies your understanding and approval of these terms. Incomplete packets will not be accepted for consideration. No payment or further deliberation will be an option.

[2.0] ESSAY: The essay should consist of 500 words or less and clearly state why you are the most deserving candidate for The 2016 Tenfold Initiative Scholarship. Special consideration will be given to those students demonstrating a financial need through their essay. Please include what attracted you to The Tenfold Initiative Scholarship, what art means to you, your future plans to give back to the art community, and your personal goals for incorporating art into your future academic and career plans. Please type your essay, double-spaced and in black ink.

[3.0] REFERRALS: Please include two letters of recommendation, including one teacher from your high school career; preferably an art teacher. The teacher should be familiar with your work, goals and work ethic. Please do not submit letters of recommendation from personal friends or family. In addition, please include your referrals contact information (Name, phone number and/or email) in the event we need to contact them for further information.

[4.0] DEADLINE: Applications should be submitted with four (4) samples (printed or on disk), essay, and two letters of recommendation by Monday, June 20, 2016 to LaineGabriel c/o The Tenfold Initiative Scholarship, 1266 Manning Parkway, Suite D, Powell, Ohio 43065. Please be sure to send all materials together in one package and clearly state your name on each piece. Questions, concerns or comments may be sent via email to LISA@ LAINEGABRIEL.COM. The scholarship winner will be notified via email and/or by phone by July 11th.

[5.0] SELECTION: Selection will be determined by quality of all samples and information included, and an implied need emphasis will be on the four samples and essay.

[6.0] SCHOLARSHIP: One (1) \$1,500 non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to the top candidate to be used towards tuition required by the educational institution for the upcoming 2016-2017 academic school year. LaineGabriel will directly notify the recipient and award the scholarship directly to the Bursar/Financial Office of the student's chosen college for the 2016-2017 school year (Payment will be broken down into two payments of \$750 over the course of the school year). In addition to the \$1,500 scholarship, the selected candidate's referring high school art teacher will be awarded one (1) \$150 gift card to Blick's for his or hers' classroom or personal use.
